RESPONSIBILITIES

The PreCast Superintendent (PS) will:

- Focus on and contribute to an SSHE mind-set and performance within the SDP construction organization
- Coordinating and overseeing all precast work.
- Participate in supervision and the overall safety and quality on the precast operation.
- Ensure implementation of all SSHE requirements and safety roles are established for the department and all subcontractors involved within the team.
- Plan and schedule work related to the precast operation, project requirements, specifications, schedules, and budget.

MAIN TASKS AND DELIVERABLES

- Ensure implementation of all procedures and work packages related to precast work are followed.
- Ensure that precast operation activities are executed in accordance with specifications budget and time schedules.
- Assist with preparation and execution of various precast operations, including formwork & rebar installation, MMO, crane lifts and concrete pours.
- Understand what tolerances need to be met within the different areas of the precast operation.
- Monitor and supervise all the different teams to ensure compliance of work.
- Responsible to monitor construction productivity and schedule performances and investigate reasons for less than satisfactory performance. Provide recommendations and institute measures for improvement.
- Responsible for reading, understanding and interpreting construction drawings.
- Follow up on the daily precast activities to ensure safety and quality standards are met.
- Procure necessary tools and equipment required to carry out precast operations.
- Ensure correct person power is in place for all areas of work.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Minimum of 10+ years' experience in installation and management of formwork, rebar, concrete and MMO operations.
- Precast operations experience is an asset.
- Proficient with MS office word and Excel.
- Familiar with unionized work environments and project collective agreements.
- Ability to prepare work plans and ensure they are aligned for precast operations.
- Great deal of Attention to detail.
- Excellent interpersonal skills and ability work well within teams.
