RESPONSIBILITIES

The MMO Superintendent (MMO-S) will:

- Coordinate and monitor craft quality, productivity, and performance with regards to all the main mechanical outfitting.
- Ensuring work is completed in accordance with contract scope and completed to schedule milestones.

MAIN TASKS AND DELIVERABLES

- Focus will be on overseeing installation of Structural and Piping components.
- Negotiate and monitor changes to the work scope caused by design and filed changes and site conditions.
- Collaborate with the Contracts Administrator to raise the required documentation for the quantification and approval of any changes.
- Continuously monitor the Contractor's safety HSSE performance and ensure that the Contractor's scope of services is delivered in accordance with the construction schedule and the required design quality requirements.
- Perform shop inspections to ensure quality and engineering requirements are being met during construction.
- Work with field engineering to resolve issues which arise during construction.
- Perform shop inspections to ensure quality and engineering requirements are being met during structural steel fabrication and mechanical packages.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Technical degree or diploma in a mechanical engineering or construction related field. An equivalent combination of training and work experience may be considered.
- Prefer a strong background in heavy mechanical work (crushers, conveyors, pumps).
- Minimum of 15+ years' experience in installation and management of mechanical systems, more relevance if in large construction projects.
- Ability to prepare work plans and ensure they are aligned for installation operations.
- Exceptional analytical, problem solving, planning, and organizing abilities.
- Strong interpersonal skills combined with a positive, team-oriented attitude.
- Excellent communication and reporting skills.
- Ability to successfully pass pre-employment/pre-site access drug testing.
- Ability to travel and work on site in Argentinia, NL.
