Package: P-A2831 Rental of Work & Rescue Boats

Scope of Work:

Rental of Work & Rescue Boats for the West White Rose Project at Argentia Construction Site in Newfoundland (NL), Canada. The approximate rental period is July 2024 to April 2025.

The rental shall satisfy the requirements to be stated in the "Work & Rescue Boats Specification" to be issued with the Bid Package. All EOI respondents will be given the opportunity to submit a proposal through a Request for Quote (RFQ) and will receive the full Bid Package.

Workboat (Rental) – Brief Summary Specification:

The workboat should preferably be aluminum, with a clear open deck with a small enclosed cabin/console at the stern (Rear of enclosure can be canvas if existing console only has front and sides. The boat must have a crane that can reach 8'+ outside the gunwalls of the boat with a capacity of 1500lbs plus at max reach. The boats Transport Canada cargo/people capacity must be at least 500kg above the weight of the completely outfitted and fully fueled boat plus the max crane capacity (Transport Canada Max Capacity > Outfitted boat weight + max crane capacity). This is so there is no situation where the cranes capacity can overload the capacity of the unloaded boat. Bow preference is a landing platform plus bumpers to butt the bow against larger structures. The boat must have intelligent joystick docking controls for ease of maneuvering. Munson 30-35-Hero Utility with landing platform or similar style (https://www.munsonboats.com/models/30-series/).

Rescue Boat (Rental) – Brief Summary Specification:

The rescue boat should be a rigid hull inflatable from 20' to 25' with a standard console with hydraulic steering. It must have capacity for 6+ people and/or 1000+kg cargo. This boat should have all typical rescue equipment like winches, ropes along the collar/pontoon, etc. An example of the boat type we are looking for is the Polaris Boats Solas FRC style (https://www.polarisboats.com/boats/6-meter-frc-solas-fast-rescue-craft/) or similar.

The West White Rose Platform is being constructed in a Graving Dock in Argentia, NL, Canada.
